*J*ournal of Addiction Medicine recognizes individuals for their contributions to the journal this past year. Patrick Krill, MA, JD, LL.M, is the winner of the Most Viewed and Downloaded Paper award with 1650 full-text views or downloads in 2017 (10 times more than last year's number, Altmetrics score in the top 5% of research outputs at 795 on March 12, 2018) of his article entitled "The Prevalence of Substance Use and Other Mental Health Concerns Among American Attorneys" (Krill et al., 2016).

The Journal also recognizes Jan Gryczynski, PhD, and Andrew Saxon, MD, as the (tied) winners of the Most Reviewed Articles award for peer reviewing 6 each in 2017. These annual awards, with modest monetary prizes and public recognition, started in 2016, and recognize the successes and efforts of authors and reviewers who help support the quality and impact of the *Journal*. The awards were presented at the Editorial Board Meeting held as part of the annual meeting of the American Society of Addiction Medicine, in San Diego, CA, on April 13, 2018.
